Speeding (Mph over posted limit)	
1 to 10	3
11 to 20	4
21 to 30	6
31 to 40	8
More than 40	11
Reckless Driving	5
Failure to stop for a School Bus	5
Following too closely (tailgating)	4
Inadequate Brakes (while driving employer's vehicle)	2
Failing to Yield Right-Of-Way	3
Violation Involving Traffic Signal, Stop Sign, or Yield Sign	3
Railroad Crossing Violation	3
Improper Passing or Lane Use	3
Leaving scene of an incident involving property damage or injury to an animal	3
Safety restraint violation involving person under 16	3
Any other moving violation	2

-Accumulation of 11 points within an 18 month period results in a DMV hearing for suspension/revocation of driving privilege in the State of NY.

-Points are assessed as of violation date.

-License privilege may be revoked for other reasons regardless of point accumulation, i.e. 3 speeding violations within an 18 month period results in a mandatory revocation.
