New York Count is Critical

- Only Opportunity for next 10 years
- \$53 Billion Annually in Federal Funding for Housing, Highways, Health Care and Education
- New York Influence in Congress – Redistricting
- Critical Data for Economic Development and Planning

First Steps: LUCA

Local Update of Census Addresses

- Register to Participate **NOW** (Deadline 12/15)
- Prepare Local Address Files Now thru February '18
- Review Census LUCA Files Starting February '18
- Submit Corrected Files 120 Days after receiving LUCA File

➤ Population Count – April 2020

- Building Community Outreach Partnerships
- Hard to Count Populations
- Technical Challenges
- Confidentiality – guaranteed by Federal Law
