2022 NYSAC Fall Seminar 1 2 **Standing Committee on Public Safety Resolution #6** 3 4 Resolution Urging the State to Provide Counties with Funding to 5 6 Administer Medication Assisted Treatment in Correctional Facilities 7 8 WHEREAS, in October 2022, the State of New York will require that all prisons and 9 jails in New York State provide medication assisted treatment (MAT) to incarcerated individuals afflicted with a substance use disorder; and 10 11 **WHEREAS**, the State of New York has appropriated funding to cover the costs of MAT 12 in state prisons but not in county jails; and 13 14 **WHEREAS**, the scope of services required by the law far exceeds the furnishings of 15 addiction medication but also requires comprehensive peer support, counseling, re-16 entry planning and discharge planning; and 17 18 **WHEREAS**, it is estimated that between thirty and forty percent of all new jail 19 admissions would qualify for treatment; and 20 21 **WHEREAS**, there is currently \$8.25 million appropriated in the Aid to Localities 22 23 section of the State Fiscal Year 2023 budget to support the 58 county jails outside of New York City in providing these services. 24 25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the New York State Association of 26 Counties (NYSAC) calls on the State of New York to provide an additional \$20 million in 27 28 state funding to support these new responsibilities that fall entirely on county 29 government entities; and 30 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, state aid for this program shall be disbursed in an 31 expedited manner to allow counties to deploy grant funding in a timely manner; and 32 33 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, copies of this resolution be sent to the counties of 34 New York State encouraging member counties to enact similar resolutions; and 35 36 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that NYSAC shall forward copies of this resolution to 37 the Governor of the State of New York, the New York State Legislature, and all others 38 deemed necessary and proper. 39
