- 11 Intervention Provider Agreement for providers to serve equally families who speak a
- language other than English, providers are free to choose which families to provide
- 13 Early Intervention services to; and
- 14 WHEREAS, since the rates for bilingual Core Evaluation are insufficient, and
- providers are still responsible for paying interpreters if a family cancels or does not
- show up for an appointment, this reduces the incentive for providers to serve children
- who speak a language other than English.
- 18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the New York State Association of
- 19 Counties (NYSAC) calls on the Governor and State Legislature to allocate State funding
- 20 for a 15 percent rate increase for Core Bilingual Evaluation; and
- 21 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that NYSAC calls on the Governor and State
- Legislature to establish a mechanism to reimburse providers for interpreter fees when a
- family cancels the evaluation without enough notice to cancel the interpreter; and
- 24 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, copies of this resolution be sent to the counties of
- New York encouraging member counties to enact similar resolutions; and
- 26 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the NYSAC shall forward copies of this resolution to
- 27 Governor Kathy Hochul, the New York State Legislature and all others deemed
- 28 necessary and proper.
