## Resolution Urging the Governor and Legislature to Address the Severe Deficit of Qualified Home Health Care Professionals in New York

6 **WHEREAS**, COVID-19 has dramatically increased the demand for in home services,

7 with clients and their families preferring to receive care in their own homes rather than

- 9 WHEREAS, New York has not been able to attract qualified home health care
- 10 professionals to fulfill these needs even before COVID-19, and we need concrete 11 solutions to address this urgent need; and

- 13 supporting three categories one of which is *Supporting and Strengthening the Direct*

- which expands capacity of programs and access does not directly give any compensation
- 17 to the direct line staff; and

- career ladders,
  assistance with
  - assistance with transportation (car loan forgiveness) or bus passes,
- a traveling per diem staff pool,
- assistance with childcare,
- job sharing,

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- career milestone incentives, among others, and
- standardizing language and communication needs; and
- WHEREAS, counties stand at the ready to be part of this solution/dialogue to address
   recruitment and retention of qualified home health care professionals so we can all
- 30 fulfill our mission and have our communities safely age in place in their own homes.

- 32 Counties (NYSAC) calls on the Governor and Legislature to support programs that will
- 33 encourage recruitment and retention in our long-term care workforce; and
