WHEREAS, Chapter 23 of the Laws of 1989 established the Preschool Program for
Children with Handicapping Conditions as 4410 of the Education Law; and
WHEREAS, the original law included a provision to limit the county fiscal
responsibility to 25 percent by the 1993-94 school year; and
WHEREAS, section 4410 of the Education Law entitles counties to receive
administrative cost reimbursement of seventy-five (\$75) dollars per eligible preschool
student with a disability; and
WHEREAS, the administrative cost reimbursement rate of seventy-five (\$75) dollars
per eligible preschool student with a disability has not been increased in almost twenty
years for counties and does not meet the needs of the existing expenses.

Counties (NYSAC) calls on Governor Kathy Hochul and the New York State Legislature
to increase the administrative cost reimbursement rate for counties to match the same
